Eligibility: A contestant may be any amateur woman golfer with a USGA handicap index of 17.4 or below (by 6/15 revision), who is an active member of one of the NEWGA member state associations or is a legal resident of one of the six New England States. NEWGA associations may invite non-members who are residents of their state and have a handicap that meets the entry requirements. A junior is any girl who is a resident of the respective state and has not reached her 19th birthday by the opening day of the tournament. A junior of 18 years of age is eligible only if she has not yet begun her first semester of college. A junior does not have to be a member of a NEWGA member club but must have a USGA handicap index of 19.0 or below.

Parents or guardians are NOT allowed to caddie for juniors. Seniors must be 50 years old and Legends must be 65 years old by the opening day of the tournament.

Entries: Open May 1, 2018 and close June 23, 2018. Handicap revision wait list date is June 15, 2018.

Entry Fee: \$185 per player includes tee gift, range balls and competitors' barbecue following play on Tuesday, July 10th. Cart rental fee is \$20.00 per day. **Junior Fee: \$100.** VSWGGA will pay the difference. NO REFUNDS for withdrawals after June 29th.

Brief Description of Tournament/Format: A 54-hole stroke play event is open to 108 players from CT, ME, MA, NH, RI, and VT (quota of 18 players per state). If a state is unable to fill its allotted positions, the unused positions will be divided equally among the states that have a waiting list. A "Wait List" for greater than 18 applicants from a state is created by handicap index for each state after all states have entered their player lists. After 36 holes of play, a cut to the 70 (low score) players (including ties) for the final round of play, including anyone within 10 shots of the leader in the player's respective age division. A cut may be determined by the field size. Players are chosen based on lowest handicap by index as of the USGA revision effective July 1, 2018. The use of distance measuring devices will be allowed in this championship by local rule.

Prize Structure: Total number of payouts will be based on a policy of paying 1/3 of the field. Six places will be awarded for overall net winners only after all gross winners have been determined. Additional prizes along with certificates will be awarded to the Champion, Runner-Up, Junior, Senior and Legend winners. The gift certificates can and must be redeemed at any New England pro shop by July 1, 2019.

Practice Round: Available June 1st thru July 8th by calling the Pro Shop at 207-781-3104. Practice round costs are \$40.00 greens fee and \$20.00 cart fee. Competitors only (no guests).
